



## Apply for Funds for Firewise Practices

Cook County has received a State of Minnesota DNR Firewise Grant. The purpose of the grant is to assist property owners within the county in improving defensible space around their homes and also to improve access for emergency vehicles. There is a 50/50 cost share for all approved costs incurred on approved projects. The grant will pay up to \$1,000 per property, with the property owner matching the Firewise funds with hired labor.

All properties are required to have a Level 2 Firewise Assessment completed prior to the work being done. Reimbursable expenses incur once the Firewise coordinator has been to your property and has created a plan for you. Expenses incurred before that time are NOT reimbursable. Receipts are required for reimbursements.
